- Since the economic meltdown that started in 2019, the currency has collapsed and drove **more than 82% of the population to live in poverty**.
- Today **1.3 million Lebanese are in need of health assistance**, according to the World Health Organization (WHO).
- The **Government Healthcare budget has collapsed from around 600 million USD in 2018 to 20 million USD in 2022**; the healthcare infrastructure has been acutely depleting.
- **Since 1991, The René Moawad Foundation (RMF)'s journey began with one mobile dispensary clinic** catering to Akkar's medical needs. Our healthcare services have considerably expanded to respond to the needs of communities in northern remote areas through **3 mobile clinics covering more than 100 underprivileged villages** on a regular basis, offering free check-ups, medicines, and health awareness.
- Despite the dramatic developments, through its current health facilities, **RMF was able to reach 33,202 beneficiaries** in the health sector in 2022. The **MEDCHRONIC program** aims at leveraging RMF's existing infrastructure **to target an additional 3,000 patients per month**, suffering from chronic diseases.
- Ensuring a consistent mobile clinics' routing system and a service schedule. The schedule will comprise the date and time at which the mobile clinics will be present in each village in the targeted districts and the remote areas where residents cannot access a medical center.
- Identification of patients based on the existing vulnerability criteria and the data base that RMF is maintaining.
- The program will target and serve **patients with chronic diseases**, excluding cancer patients.
- Registered doctors will be monitoring the applications from a medical perspective and requesting additional tests from patients if necessary.

- To implement the **MEDCHRONIC program**, RMF will be contributing its existing resources and know-how.

The program will request an additional cost of which includes:

20 USD/patient/month

cost of generic medicines, operation budget (mainly covering the mobile clinic's operation cost), as well as specialized human-resources directly linked to the operation. The requested amount to implement the

MEDCHRONIC program is 720,000 USD/year.
